Many of us have experienced the frustration associated with trying to hear and understand our tour guides. Group travelers often challenge their tour guides as they jockey for a position close enough to hear the guide's tour commentary. Tour guides, communicating with their groups, often have no alternative but to raise their voices to get their message heard.

ieXplore provides Tour Directors with a wireless commentary system that enables guides to speak in a comfortable tone of voice with their tour groups. Guides speak to their entire group as if the group was an arms length away – communicating over distances as far as 100 feet.
